Welcome Scholarships for Catholic School Students

The Welcome Scholarship fund is a new program open to any student not previously enrolled in a Catholic school of the Saginaw Diocese, regardless of religious affiliation or household income. The scholarship is being funded by a generous \$100,000 contribution from the Saginaw-based Wolohan Family Foundation, with a match by the Diocese. Scholarships are available for the 2019-2020 academic year.
