Eagle Update

Twenty-ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time

GOSPEL: Matthew 22: 15-21

The Pharisees in today's Gospel reading were trying to trick Jesus and make him say something wrong. Jesus knew what the Pharisees were trying to do. Jesus asked them to show the coins, and asked whose picture was on it. They replied Caesar. So he told them "Then repay to Caesar what is Caesar's and to God what is God's." He is telling them they should obey the rules of the land, but also that they should obey God.

We have two kinds of Laws: God's laws and laws of our government. Both are for our own good, but God's law should be our priority.

The lunch program is in the final stages of being approved from the state and should be finalized this week. We have started to ramp up our ordering and should be ready for many more lunches to be served. The goal was to have everything established by the first week of November, and I can state that we will be able to reach that goal. Alternative lunches will also be covered under the new lunch program and you can always use that lunch to supplement a sandwich from home. (i/e get a yogurt, fruit, PBJ, and muffin bites to go with your sandwich from home.)
