GOSPEL: Mark 1:21-28

In this week's Gospel, Jesus' command and conviction in both his teaching and deeds were so powerful that witnesses were amazed and astonished. This dramatic reading gives us a glimpse into the charismatic person that Jesus was. Do we have a similar response to Jesus' words and deeds?

Explain to your children that bad feelings, such as anger or jealousy, make our spirits "unclean." Make a list with your children of all the ways they might be separated from God lately – that is, when they've been mad at someone, when they've hurt someone, when they don't feel loved, when they forget to pray, and so on. Talk about how these things stand between us and God. How might we keep our heart and mind ready and accepting of God's love and presence?
