Eagle Update

GOSPEL: Luke 24:36-40, 44-48

Once again we hear, this time from Luke that Jesus' first words to his disciples after his Resurrection were "Peace be with you." How important that phrase is! When we share the Sign of Peace during Mass, we are remembering that true peace can only come from one source. When our souls are at peace, we are unafraid and able to listen and follow the voice of God.

Peace is a theme in much of the music we sing at Mass and in many catechesis programs as well. Ask your children if they know any songs that have the word *peace* in them, or find songs from Mass (for example, "Prayer for Peace," "Peace is Flowing Like a River," "Let there Be Peace on Earth," "Make Me a Channel of Your Peace," and so on). If your children are old enough to read, choose a song and copy the lyrics on a poster board. Practice singing the songs daily. Include them in your prayers before bed or as the children are getting ready for their day. Let these songs fill your hearts and help your family bring the peace of God into your lives.

The staff has been doing a wonderful job this year. Thank you for all your hard work. I don't say it publicly enough, but I am very proud to work with all of you.

This week we had our first shut down of the entire year.
