GOSPEL: Mark 10: 2-9, 13-16

Jesus speaks about the beauty of marriage and the blessings that are the stronghold of the couple as they journey together through life. The holiness and grace within that act of commitment between two people can never be undone. Every day this commitment is a choice a family makes over and over again. Pope Francis wrote about families in “The Joy of Love” (Amoris laetitia), focusing on the joys and the challenges of married life. It is a wonderful message for all couples.

In today’s Gospel, Jesus blessed the children that were brought to him. Remind your children that on the day of their baptism Jesus also blessed them with his light and life. Bless one another, using a sign from the baptismal rite. With your thumb, make a small sign of the cross on the forehead of the person next to you. Continue until each person has been blessed.
