GOSPEL: Mark 9: 30-37

It is natural to want success and to accomplish or do something well. But how should we define success? Jesus gives us a wise way to measure it: He teaches us that greatness comes when we put ourselves at the service of others, just as he did throughout his life.

Examples of greatness do not always appear in the places we expect. Jesus offered one example when he placed a child in the midst of the apostles. Let us look for examples of greatness among the least of us, the poor, the stranger, and even those who are the hardest to love.

Explain to your children what servant leadership means. Then invite each family member to name one person who is an example of service to others by what they say or do. What makes this person great and a servant to all? Say a prayer thanking God for these people who are great in the eyes of Jesus.

We have started NWEA testing our children. Your teachers will reach out to you to give more specific dates, but the expectation is for the children to try their best. We will use this data to understand our children and group them appropriately with other students needing the same skills.
